The NCBF Listserv member service is a valuable tool and a way for you to instantly pose a question to all members and get a fast response. But, just how do you use it - where do those responses go and what happens when you hit "reply"?

Here are three simple pointers to get you started:

1. By sending a message to NCBF@mail.americanbar.org, you will reach all current NCBF members.
2. If you receive a LISTSERV question in your mailbox and want to respond only to the person asking the question, just hit "reply".
3. If you want to respond to EVERYONE, hit "reply all".
